JOB DESCRIPTION

Job title: Hockey Pro/Graduate Sports Assistant

Main purpose of the job

The successful applicant will be required to coach sport at all levels from Year 7 to Upper Sixth. The applicant should be able to coach at a high level in Hockey and one or more of the following sports: Netball; Badminton, Cricket, Football or Athletics. Applications from candidates able to coach/umpire in Netball would be considered more favourably.

Main responsibilities and duties

The successful applicant will be involved in coaching sport at Queenswood School. This will entail working with students through both the Physical Education and Co-curricular programmes. Support and development of the fixture programme will be an integral part of this role. Responsibilities include:

- Planning and coaching sessions throughout the year for pupils of all ages and abilities.
- Giving due consideration to the needs of individual pupils and thus ensuring that all pupils are working and developing at their own pace.
- Looking to develop individual sporting needs, as well as team strategies.
- Working to ensure the professional development of the pupils.
- Assisting with Queenswood Schools' Key Stage 2 Outreach Programme.
- Selecting and managing teams as and when required (to include after school, weekends and occasional school holidays).
- Officiating at competitions and fixtures and assisting with events hosted by the PE department.
- Willingness and flexibility to be actively involved in the management and maintenance of equipment and facilities.
- Fitness testing of elite athletes, scholars and squad players.
- Supervision of the fitness suite, induction of staff and students.
- Promotion of healthy, active and balanced lifestyles to pupils and staff.
- Promoting professional standards of punctuality, discipline and sportsmanship with all the pupils, taking appropriate action where necessary.

No list of responsibilities can really encompass all that is asked of the Hockey Pro/ Graduate Sports Assistant; at the heart of his or her task is an active enthusiasm for sport and an equally active enthusiasm for the young people being taught. Other duties may be deemed appropriate to the role by the Principal.

This job may suit a young person taking a gap year and could also be a student from abroad. The applicant may be considering a future in Physical Education or Sport. This role is a great opportunity to gain valuable work experience and training in a highly successful and professional environment. All Sports Graduates/Assistant Coaches/ Sports Pros are expected to play a full role in the life of the School outside the classroom. They will be required to live on site and assist in a Boarding House one evening per week.

Queenswood has its own salary scale, which will be discussed at interview. Accommodation (including term time meals) will be available for the successful applicant.
